



Youth Work Qualifications 2018

Our **Youth Work Courses**, delivering **Qualifications in Youth Work Practice**, for workers from across **London and the South East**, are now open for Applications. The courses are provided by a working Partnership between *The Lifetrain Trust*, “*Double Two*” Consultancy and *The Harrow Club W10*.

WE ARE NOW OPEN TO APPLICANTS FOR NEW COURSES TO COMMENCE IN October 2018

Three Youth Work courses are offered:-

1. **Level 2 Certificate in Youth Work Practice** – x8 Units + x1 Option Unit
2. **Level 3 Certificate in Youth Work Practice** – x8 Units + x1 Option Unit
3. A **Conversion Course** for those who completed a L2 Certificate in Youth Work Practice after April 2016 and wish to upgrade to a Level 3 Certificate - x4 Units + x1 Option Unit

All courses will be delivered as taught courses on Saturdays at three or four weekly intervals between **October 2018 and June 2019**. The course is evidence based, accessible and inclusive for all. You will:

- be involved in live training sessions with your peers involving input, course handouts, discussions and working on agreed tasks,
- have direct face-to-face support from a designated assessor
- have regular Tutorial support from the Training team, including help with portfolio building
- have regular feedback on progress

The Venue will be The Harrow Club W10, 187 Freston Road, London W10 6TH. The centre is very near to Latimer Road Tube Station, on the Hammersmith & City and the Circle Lines.

Applications should be returned as soon as possible. Interviews will be arranged with individuals once applications are received. The final closing date for applications for these courses is **Wednesday 12th September 2018**.
